

How to Use the Text to Speech Feature

How to Highlight Text

- * **Click and Hold:** Place your cursor at the beginning of the text you want to highlight.
- * **Drag:** While holding the mouse button, drag your cursor to the end of the text. The selected text will change color.
- * **Release:** Let go of the mouse button once you have selected all the text you need.

On a Tablet or Smartphone:

- Press and Hold:** Tap and hold your finger on a word.
- Adjust:** Drag the blue handles to expand the highlighted area to cover the text you want.
